## Minutes:

- Goal for this year:
  - Each student will progress in their individual education plan goals in the areas of communication, occupational therapy, physical therapy, orientation & mobility, vision, and hearing.
- This year's budget: \$2698.78
- Occupational Therapist: Paul Daybell
  - The classrooms have some many sensory items that each classroom really is a sensory room.
  - Having sensory opportunities in the classroom really is better because that is where the supervision is, and students can have access to it at all times.
  - Each classroom has a quiet room where students can take a break (including the multipurpose room).
  - So often, the sensory room is for a break. Our students have more pressure and movement needs.
  - We need to be cautious about the visual sensory items due to fire code issues.
  - Paul recommends a more peaceful sensory room as far as visual goes, and maybe include some tactile sensory items in the ball pit room.
  - We already have:
    - Multiple swings in each room
    - Beanbags
    - Trampolines
    - Textured boxes and materials
    - Projectors and screens in classrooms (visual and musical stimulation)
    - Padded mats
    - Yoga balls
  - Discussion of sensory purchases / Ideas for sensory room (prioritized):
    - Dark curtains for the walls
    - TV that could connect to and project an iPad through an Apple TV
      - Maybe 55" (\$300ish)
      - iTunes music visualizer
      - Bluetooth switches to activate things on the TV
    - Mats to lay on
    - Switch activation for lights and projectors

- Texture wall with different fabrics, artificial grass, etc.
- Inexpensive projectors that project the ocean (or something similar)
- Mirrored light ball with tower
- LED rope lights--Will that be in line with fire code?
- Round mesh seats
- Sensa-Rock
- Sensory Pea Pod
- Motion to move forward with sensory room purchase. Seconded and all agreed.
